Project Objective	<p>The target area, Nangarhar district, is one of the main destinations for more than 450,000 people who voluntarily returned after 2016. The infrastructure and social services in the area are heavily burdened, and it is recognized as a region of great concern, especially in the water and sanitation sector. Under such circumstances, the awareness of the sanitary conditions of internally displaced persons, returnees and host communities, especially in the most severe situations, will be improved and they will obtain the minimum amount of safe water without compromising their dignity. It is the purpose of this project to be done.</p>	
Project Overview	<p>This project is targeted at the Chaparhar district of Nangarhar district of Afghanistan. Build deep solar-powered wells and plumbing to provide beneficiaries with continuous access to safe drinking water. In addition, a well management committee (WMC) consisting of beneficiaries and stakeholders will be organized to build a sustainable management system. Furthermore, by providing hygiene education and hygiene kits, we will improve the hygiene environment and prevent the spread of infectious diseases including the new coronavirus (hereinafter, new corona).</p>
